Springfield Celebrates 150 Years! 1868—2018

"Remembering the Past and Looking toward to the Future."

Celebration Weekend: September 29, 30, 2018 with Tentative Schedule:



Saturday September 29th: 3 pm sharing, remembering, renewing perhaps with a skit reviewing the important aspects of our history followed by a light meal together and a hymn sing with our anniversary cake & ice cream in the evening (shared with previous pastors and area CoB churches)

Sunday, September 30th: children's play, worship, noon meal and closing activities. Bethany Seminary president, Jeff Carter will be our speaker at Sunday's service.

- Be thinking of a memory you have of the church or what the church has meant to you. You will be receiving a card to write your memories on.
- Bring & share "photos" of church families and happenings.
- Looking for people to participate in a skit. Our theme is "Remembering the Past and Looking toward the Future."

Looking back to 1995-2007

A church awning was built at the entrance doors on the west side of the church in 1995. It was donated by the Glenn Hawk family. Pastor Steve suggested that mailboxes be built at the back of the sanctuary with Don Sheets building them in 1996. A motion was made at Council Meeting in 1996 to raise the price of cemetery lots from \$50 to \$250 each. That year a Family Night program was started for members to come and eat for \$3. This was an evening of fellowship with all helping cook and clean up. Activities were planned following the meal.

In 1997 a new church steeple was erected. Property on the east side of the church was purchased at an auction with the house razed in 2001. Also in 2001 an elevator lift was installed. Tim Carver from Bridgewater served as a summer intern in 2001 and 2002.

Kris Hawk felt the call to the ministry and was licensed in 2003 (and later ordained) serving part time as Pastor of Visitation. A Vision Statement for the church was developed and passed in 2003. Monica Rice, a Manchester student served as a summer intern in 2003. In 2003 Brethren Table ended; it had lasted 11 years. Family night then delivered meals to the shut-ins of the church each week. New sanctuary blinds were purchased by the Women's Fellowship. A needed new roof was installed in 2004. A new church secretary was hired in 2004 and a student intern, Rachel McFadden, from Manchester served that summer.

Pastor Steve resigned June 25, 2006 to begin working for the General Board as a Work Camp Coordinator. Tom Michaels served as an interim pastor until Andrew Hamilton was called to serve at Springfield in June 2007. A new program "Springs of Living Water" was started in the fall. Pastor Andy also taught study groups and taught a Sunday school class.
