Nikki Conner and Janet Watkins have been chosen District Conference Delegates. District Conference will be July 29-30 at the Maple Grove CoB.

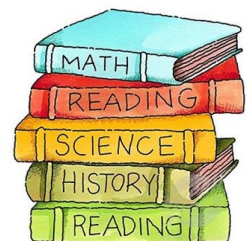
Condolences

The Spring Fling Dinner will be Saturday, May 21st. We hope to see you all there!

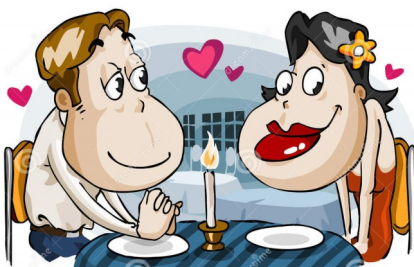

We will be serving from 4:30 pm to 7:00 pm. Please mark your preference. We will contact you to confirm the exact time of your reservation.

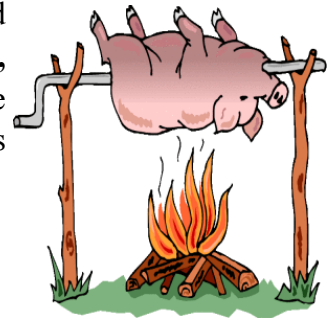
