Choir Practice The choir meets Thursday evenings at 7 pm to practice All are welcome to join the choir.

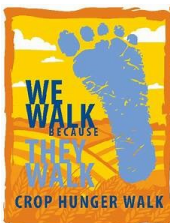
Mum Sunday will be October 13th.
